THE BAY WINES - THE KNOWLEDGE

Soleus – Organic Sauvignon Blanc and Merlot

Soleus is produced by MontGras, who are very conscious of the sustainability and biodiversity of all their vineyards. The grapes of the Soleus wines come from the Aurora Estate from Teno in the Central Valley. Watered with pure Andean snow melt water, the vineyards benefit from the reliable Chilean sunshine and cool Pacific breezes. Winemaker Santiago Margozzini is in charge of selecting the fruit and crafting the Soleus range of wines, which are barrel aged and complex, and produced in limited quantities.

Biddenden Vineyards

The vineyards were established by the Barnes family in 1969. Starting with one acre the vineyards has grown to 22 acres with nine varieties of grapes grown. Set on a gentle south facing slope in a shallow sheltered valley, ideal conditions for vines. Predominantly German varieties are grown including Ortega, Huxelrebe, Bacchus, Schönburger and Reichensteiner. Together with Pinot Noir, Gamay and Dornfelder the vineyards are able to produce White, Red, Rosé and Sparkling Wines. Harvest of the grapes takes place late September, visitors can see the presses in operation in the winery. Bottling of the wines commences early in the following year.

Henriot – Champagne Brut Souverain

The Henriot Family has been in Champagne since the 16th Century, Stanislas Henriot the current Chairman is the 12th generation to be involved in the Champagne business. In 1808, the family decided to sell their wines under the Champagne Henriot label, hitherto only reserved for family and friends. Now based in Reims Champagne Henriot's wines can be found in the finest restaurants, hotels and specialist wine shops around the world.

Mansion House Bay – Sauvignon Blanc

Mansion House Bay was formed in 1993 and by Greg and Sue White, and winemaker, Simon Waghorn. Their aim was to establish a winery in Marlborough producing premium quality varietal wines. To achieve this they have brought together a leading New Zealand winemaker, a dedicated group of growers, and a small modern winery facility where top quality fruit can receive the 'hands-on' treatment that it needs to achieve its full potential.

Thornbury – Pinot Noir

Thornbury matches the very best of New Zealand's wine regions with the best varieties to create wines that are distinctive and memorable. The image of the dancing piper that adorns each bottle of Thornbury wine is Dionysus, Greek God of Wine, celebrating living life to the full. It is in this spirit, that Thornbury was established in 1997 with the express intention of creating a selection of quality New Zealand wines to inspire wine lovers around the world. Thornbury believe there is space in the world for winemaking know-how to be matched with imagination and zeal to produce wines with flair and flavour.

Torres – Tormenta

Born, like the storm under the clouds and the wind of the southern continent, this white wine is the fruit born of untouched, uncontaminated nature. It is produced in Chile's Central Valley, using grapes, which are cultivated according to the demanding methods of organic agriculture and receive special care. Tormenta is a great wine, made from organically grown grapes. Its excellent qualities are verified by its IMO certification which proves that the grapes come from a herbicide, insecticide and inorganic fertilizer-free vineyard and that the wine is produced using totally traditional methods.

Bouchard Père et Fils - Brouilly

Maison Bouchard Père et Fils is one of the oldest producers and vineyard owners in the Côte d'Or. A family wine merchant business was first established by Michel Bouchard and his son Joseph in Beaune in 1731. The first vineyards were purchased in Volnay in 1791 from the French Revolutionary Government, and so began a long history of gathering fine 'Terroirs'; first in the Côte de Beaune, which is still home to the majority of the Bouchard Père et Fils Domaine, then in the Côte de Nuits, and most recently in Chablis, through the acquisition in 1998 of Domaine William Fèvre. In 1995 Bouchard Père et Fils was bought by Joseph Henriot, whose family have been growers and producers in Champagne for over 200 years. Since then, Joseph Henriot has taken every opportunity to continue the Bouchard family tradition of investing in fine vineyards, and has restored the 15th Century Château de Beaune to become a fitting home to the many thousands of bottles of fine Burgundy that lie ageing in the perfect conditions of the Château's cellars.

William Fèvre - Chablis

The William Fèvre Domaine is one of the greatest in Chablis consisting of 48 hectares, of which 12 hectares are Premiers Crus and 15 hectares are Grands Crus. The Fèvre family have been prominent in Chablis for over 250 years and William Fèvre's father founded Domaine de la Maladière in 1959. William Fèvre was a great champion of Chablis in the 1980's and built what was then the most advanced winery in the region. In 1998 William Fèvre decided to pursue his vinous interests in Chile and Joseph Henriot picked up the torch and installed an inspired winemaker, in the form of Didier Segulier. Since then, the wines from Domaine William Fèvre have become the benchmark for classic Chablis. Fèvre wines truly reflect the unique and diverse terroirs from which they come and produce the purest expressions of Chardonnay with great length, complexity and minerality.

Skillogalee Wines– Clare Valley Australia

Skillogalee is a 150 acre property found within the Clare Valley wine region. The property and business were purchased by Dave and Diana Palmer in 1989, however grapes were first grown on the property, in the early 1970's, on vineyards that are generally quite steep with eastern facing slopes. All the fruit for the wines from Skillogalee is produced from their own vineyards. Within Clare Skillogalee occupies the western extreme of the Sevenhill sub-region. The Skillogalee Valley represents a separate viticultural area, distinct from the main valley and the Polish Hill Valley further west. It is separated from the main valley by a distinct north-south ridge. Rainfall tends to be a little higher than other parts of the Valley.

Chateaufort du Pape – Rhone

13 grape varieties used in the wine are Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault, Muscardin, Vaccarese, Picpoul, Terret Noir, Rousanne, Grenache Blanc, Clairette, Bourboulenc and Picardin
